Exam Results

Results are out for the Level 1 and Level 2 exams that took place last month – Level 3 candidates have to wait a few more weeks to find out.

Initial indications are that we have had good success rates with Israeli-based candidates, with a significant number passing their respective exams.

According to a report published on Bloomberg News, forty-seven percent of applicants worldwide passed the Level II exams in June, up from 46 percent in 2016. The pass rate for Level 1 was unchanged from last year at 43 percent.
